EASY-FREEZE BABY FOOD



Face it, baby food is boring and freezing your own is a chore, especially when it comes to gouging the tiny portions out of ice cube trays. Perth mum Alexandra Wardle became so frustrated with it all that she designed Qubies (\$16.95), an upside-down ice cube container that stores and freezes mush and goop into convenient meal-sized 30ml portions that are easily released because the dividers are on the non-stick, flexible silicone lid rather than on the rigid polycarbonate base. You put the puree in the base, snap on the lid and pop in the freezer for fuss-free portions, which can be left in the tray or emptied into freezer bags. The containers are handy for freezing real food as well, especially passionfruit pulp, fruit purees and tomato paste. Available in aqua and lime from www.qubies.com.au.
